He is a member of the International Psychoanalytic Association, as well as of IPTAR and the National Psychological Association for Psychoanalysis (NPAP), both at which he serves as a faculty member and clinical supervisor. He is Managing Editor of *The Undecidable Unconscious: A Journal of Deconstruction and Psychoanalysis* (University of Nebraska Press), and he is the author of *Nietzsche and the Clinic: Psychoanalysis, Philosophy, Metaphysics* (Routledge 2017) and *Psychoanalysis and Deconstruction: Freud's Psychic Apparatus* (Routledge 2019).
