

Maria Taveras is a Jungian analyst in New York City with many years of experience in private practice. She is a faculty member at the C.G. Jung Foundation and a former board member at the C.G. Jung Institute of New York and the National Association for the Advancement of Psychoanalysis. She is also an artist who paints and sculpts archetypal images from her own dreams. She is the recipient of two Gradiva Awards from the National Association for the Advancement of Psychoanalysis for her "Dream Art." Her paintings and sculptures have been exhibited in New York, London, Cape Town, Montreal, San Francisco, and Berkeley. She has recently published two important articles – "Dream Art: Sculpting the Psyche" and "A Jungian Aesthetic: Art, Active Imagination, and the Creative Process." In 2013, Taveras presented her paper "A Jungian Aesthetic: Art, Active Imagination, and the Creative Process" at the International Congress of the IAAP in Copenhagen. In 2015, she was a keynote speaker at the conference of the Moscow Association for Analytical Psychology. In 2017, she presented a Master Class on Dream Art at the PEREPOSTMODERN Conference in St. Petersburg, Russia
