DAY 1: SATURDAY, OCTOBER 24TH | FLIGHT TO ITALY | MEALS: B, L

Departure from the US for overnight flight to Italy.

DAY 2: SUNDAY, OCTOBER 25TH | WELCOME TO SPOLETO! | MEALS: D

Arrival in Roma Fiumicino Airport and independent transfer to Spoleto. *Transfers are not included but we can make the arrangements for you.* Check-in to Hotel San Luca for four nights. Meet for a Welcome Dinner at a restaurant serving Umbrian specialties.

DAY 3: MONDAY, OCTOBER 26TH | SPOLETO, TRUFFLES, AND WINE | MEALS: B, D

City tour of Spoleto to see the Duomo, the Roman Theatre, and the Bridge of Towers. Afternoon truffle hunt with a tartufaiolo (truffle hunter) and his dog. Following will be a cooking class at an agriturismo (farm inn).

DAY 4: TUESDAY, OCTOBER 27TH | ORVIETO & CIVITÀ DI BAGNOREGIO | MEALS: B, L

Drive to Orvieto, famed for its gold-mosaic fronted Duomo, St. Patrick's Well, and Underground Orvieto followed by lunch. Visit Civita di Bagnoregio, founded by the Etruscans over 2,500 years ago accessed through a narrow pedestrian bridge with a panoramic view.

DAY 5: WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 28TH | NORCIA AND A CHEESE PRODUCER | MEALS: B, L

The town of Norcia is famed throughout Italy for its skilled butchers. We will enjoy lunch based on salumi (cured meats). Next, we visit a farm making cheese like ricotta and pecorino (sheep's milk cheese).

DAY 6: THURSDAY, OCTOBER 29TH | OLIVE OIL, WINE & BEVAGNA | MEALS: B, L

Travel to Perugia with stops at an oil mill and a winery followed by a light lunch at the winery. Next, we head to Bevagna, an enchanting medieval borgo (hamlet where we will stroll through the town and visit the cashmere shops that are one example of the Umbria's long tradition of textile craftsmanship).

DAY 7: FRIDAY, OCTOBER 30TH | PERUGIA, "CITY OF CHOCOLATE" | MEALS B, D

City tour of Perugia where we'll see the Piazza IV Novembre with the Fontana Maggiore surrounded by the Palazzo dei Priori and the Duomo. In the afternoon, we will visit the Perugia Chocolate Museum followed by a chocolate workshop with a Maître Chocolatier (chocolate master).

DAY 8: SATURDAY, OCTOBER 31ST | COOKING CLASS AND THE BURRI MUSEUM | MEALS: B, L

In the morning, we'll travel to Montone where Chef Giancarlo Polito ("Il Capitano") will teach us to prepare some of his specialties followed by lunch. Next, we visit the Burri Museum in Città di Castello, a former tobacco drying plant featuring the work of Alberto Burri, one of the most prominent abstract painters of the twentieth century. After returning to Perugia, free time to explore the town on your own.

DAY 9: SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 1ST | WHITE TRUFFLES & GUBBIO | MEALS: B, L

Morning excursion to Acqualagna in the neighboring Marche region for a visit to the annual White Truffle Festival. Afternoon guided tour of Gubbio, the "city of stone" which dates back to the 1300's. A few steps away is the Renaissance style Palazzo Ducale and the notorious Fontana dei Matti (madmen's fountain). According to a local legend if you run around it three times, you will go mad.

DAY 10: MONDAY, NOVEMBER 2ND | ASSISI AND GIOTTO THEN CERAMICS IN DERUTA | MEALS: B, D

In the morning, enjoy a guided tour of Assisi, one of the most sacred sites in Italy. You will admire the stunning frescoes that the great painter Giotto made in the upper church of St. Francis' Basilica between approximately 1296 and 1304. After lunch, we depart for Deruta, famous for its ceramics, with time to visit the many workshops. Farewell dinner in Perugia.

DAY 11: TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 3RD | FAREWELL TO UMBRIA | MEALS: B
